Dear CAMCOR Users,

The faculty advisory committee for CAMCOR (S. Boettcher, Dave Johnson, Darren Johnson, B. McMorrان, M. Pluth, J. Watkins), and director (K. Langworthy) announce the following rate changes for fiscal year 2019 (beginning July 1st, 2018.):

Facility wide:

All CAMCOR staff-managed instrumentation services will increase 2.5% across-the-board. Other changes to rates are as follows:

Electron Microprobe Facility - Change:

- 1) Internal rate for electron microprobe time will increase from \$10/hr to \$40/hr.

Surface Analysis Lab – Change:

- 1) External rate, without technical assistance, for AFM will increase from \$100/hr to \$160/hr. The rate with assistance will adjust to \$225/hr.
- 2) External rate, without technical assistance, for RAMAN spectrometer will increase from \$100/hr to \$130/hr. The rate with assistance will adjust to \$195/hr.
