Dear CAMCOR Users,

The faculty advisory committee for CAMCOR (S. Boettcher, Dave Johnson, Darren Johnson, B. McMorran, M. Pluth), and director (K. Langworthy) have identified budget shortfalls in FY2016 funding. To lessen projected deficits (resulting from a decrease in state level funding, and increased costs for instrument repair) the following changes will be implemented beginning July 1, 2015:

1) Tiered rates will be implemented on the following instrumentation:

<b>TEM Facility</b>

<b>Surface Analysis Facility</b>

TOF-SIMS	\$50/hr	\$40/hr

\* Off-peak rates are not applicable for service work performed by CAMCOR staff.

2) **X-Ray Facility** rate for complete crystal structures will increase from \$200/structure to \$300/structure. Data collection and unit cell determination will remain at \$125 and \$25 respectively.

3) Commercial rate for XPS services will increase 8.3%, to \$325/hr; ToF-SIMS services will increase 4.6% to \$340/hr.
