The TSA Faculty Advisory Committee (A. Karduna, H. Wang, S. Boettcher, F. Vignola) the Office of Research and Innovation (P. Jones), and TSA interim-director (K. Langworthy) have been working together to examine the financial stability and sustainability within the TSA facilities.

To respond to the rising costs of labor and supplies, a memo dated in October defined new academic rates for the TSA facilities. Though it was agreed on by the FAC, new external rates were accidentally omitted from the October memo. Please update RCF records to reflect the rate structure below, which should be effective immediately.

Internal Rates:

Machine shop services: \$45/hr

Electronic Shop services: \$45/hr

Student shop access: \$15/hr

External rates:

All TSA services: \$90/hr
